MINISTRIES AND DEPARTMENTS

OUTREACH MINISTRY

Evangelism

This department is involved in reaching out to the community through door to door evangelism and setting up food distribution centres.

Senior Visitation

Prison Ministry

The workers of this department are mature believers who go into prisons and provide a time of teaching and ministry to those who desire to attend.

ADMINISTRATION MINISTRY

Finance and Secretarial

This department is responsible for the finances of the church which is the accounting and includes record keeping, budget management, payroll and other expenses. The secretarial segment is responsible for the administrative letters, reports, and creation of pamphlets and messages and other official miscellaneous document as needed.

Follow-up

This department integrates assists and involves newcomers into the church family. Also provides follow-up for guests who have visited the church recently, and for members who have been absent from the church for a period.

Hospitality

This department services the refreshment needs of the church and gives support to all departments at their various events.

This department is the main intercessory arm of the Redeemed Christian Church of God. This group comes together at least twice a week and before any major program to intercede on behalf of the church for an impactful event.

Sharing your FAITH

Sharing your Faith

Remember you have been saved, so that you can show others the way.

Before discussing what we need to share about our faith, there are certain things we are not to do.

Do not force Christian standard on unbelieving world.

1 Corinthians. 5:12

Do not confuse people by allowing them to believe that church membership, tithing or any good works are connected with becoming a Christian

Ephesians 2: 8-10

The only thing we need to share with the unsaved is the gospel of Christ. A plan for sharing your faith might be as follows:

God's word says all are sinners, condemned to hell

Isaiah 53:6. Romans 3:10, 11, 23, Romans 5: 8, 12, Revelation 20: 15.

There is nothing a lost person can do on their own to save themselves.

Isaiah 64:6, Ephesians 2: 9.

Christ was born, crucified and resurrected to save lost people from their sin

John 3:16, 1 Timothy 1: 15

To be saved sinners must believe God's word and invite Christ into their heart by faith

John 5: 24, Acts 16:31



How to Prepare

We all need to be a clean vessel

Isaiah 52: 11,

Psalms 51: 13.

We must be able to clearly give out the simple facts of the gospel without getting bogged down with profound theological concepts.

Philip the evangelist demonstrated how to do this in the desert. *Act 8: 35*

We must avoid arguments and stick to the basic issues of man's sin and Christ's blood.

We must use the word of God.

Acts 17: 2,

2 Timothy 2: 15, 3: 14-17.

We must depend on the Holy Spirit.

John 3:15,

Acts 6: 10,

1 Corinthians. 2: 4

How to Share Your Faith

Sharing our faith is a combination of spontaneous conversation about God and premeditated ideas about the Gospel. The following are practical steps to take in witnessing for Christ.

Regularly Talk About God.

Sprinkle your ordinary conversation with occasional references to God's activity in your life. It is much

easier to share your faith when your friends know God is an integral part of who you are.

Prepare your testimony.

Learn to describe your pre-Christian life, your encounter with Christ, and subsequent changes in your life in fewer than five minutes. If you became a Christian as a Child, focus on the impact Christ has had on your adult life.

Learn a Brief Summary of the Gospel.

- Man's need - *Romans 3:23*
- Sin's penalty - *Romans 6: 23a*
- Christ's remedy - *Romans 5: 8*
- God's gift to man - *Romans 6: 23b*
- How to receive - *Romans 10: 9, 10, 13*

When you have opportunity to share Christ with someone, be sensitive to that person's readiness. Go as far as you can in the progression of mentioning the Lord, telling your story of faith, presenting the gospel and appealing for a commitment of faith in Christ. Often, you will sense that your friend has heard all her or she wants to. When you stop be sure to mention that you want to talk more about the Lord another time. Keep the subject open.

The Great Commission

Then Jesus came to them and said, *"All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."*

Matthew 28: 18-20

When Can We Share our Faith?

The question as to when we should share our faith is directly tied to when a sinner should accept Christ. God's accepted time is today.

Hebrews 3: 15, 4: 7.

The reason why we cannot afford to procrastinate is because sinners have no assurance of tomorrow.

Proverbs 27: 1,

Luke 12: 19.

Therefore, we are to witness any time, all the time, in any place and in all places.

Lead the sinner to confess his or her sins to the Lord and the bible says there is joy in heaven over a sinner that repents and also a crown of righteousness for you.
